

NICOLE PINCH PLEATED VALANCE

Please read all instructions before cutting.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- * The treatment is designed to hang on a rod with rings.
- * This valance hangs about 22" from the top of the pleat to the longest point. The end jabot hangs approximately 25". The swag has a 4" drop.
- * This Valance can be adapted to fit any width window.
- * The swag widths range from 16" to 30" wide. You can use as many swag sections as needed to fit the window.
- * A welt or trim is recommended for the bottom edge of the treatment.

FABRIC SUGGESTIONS

- * Medium or light weight fabric will work best for this pattern. An interlining is recommended.
- * A contrast or self fabric is needed for the pleat/horn and the jabot pieces.
- * If a trim is not being use on the edge, such as a tassel trim, a self or contrasting cord is recommended to give a professional look.

CALCULATING YARDAGE

Measure the width of your window and then add 4" to that measurement. Divide this number by the number of swag sections you wish to have. The resulting number should fall between 14" and 30". You will have 1 more pleat/horn section than swags.

- ** If cutting the swags on the bias, add 10" to the cut length.
Measurements are given for the widest and longest points.

Use these measurements to calculate fabric, lining, interlining, and/or contrast fabric.

Swag	37" w x 25"l	37"
Pleat/horn	23" w x 23"l	23"
Jabot	11½ "w x 25"l	15"
4" Buckram	11" for each pleat/horn	

MATERIALS NEEDED

Fabric Marking Pen
Buckram

Drapery hooks
Rod with the same amount of rings as pleat/horn sections
